July 8, 1839 in Richford, New York,
John Davison Rockefeller was born
on the descendant of a French
Huguenot family, the Roquefeuille, who
had fled France when Louis XIV
revoked the Edict of Nantes. He is the
second of a family of six children, that of

William Avery Rockefeller and Eliza Davidson. They live off the products of their farm, but also off the commercial activities of William Rockefeller. The latter, a "doctor without a diploma", also travels through the western countryside selling his vials of healing elixir.

His wife is more in charge of the children. Very pious, Baptist, she raises them in the precepts of religion and the fear of God, in rigor and austerity. *You have to work," she tells them, "save and give to the poor.*

The Rockefellers then moved to Moravia, then to Owego. It was there, at the age of twelve, that John had a revelation. He had just earned \$1 after

working hard for three days for a neighbour digging potatoes. His turkey farm brought him \$50, which he immediately loaned to a local farmer for interest. This one brings him \$3.5. He said, «*I understood that day that it is absurd to work for money: the money has to work for you.*»
